



2008 U.S. FIGURE SKATING CHAMPIONSHIPS CHAPERONE POLICY

In a continuing effort to allow for appropriate chaperone access to events and activities at the U.S. Figure Skating Championships, U.S. Figure Skating is implementing the following credential policy for the 2008 U.S. Figure Skating Championships.

1. Each U.S. Championships competitor is entitled to designate one chaperone (parent or legal guardian over the age of 18) for the 2008 U.S. Figure Skating Championships. This person will receive one chaperone credential at no charge.
2. The designated chaperone will receive a photo identification credential that will provide entry to all appropriate arena facilities, all designated chaperone areas and to all provided transportation between all official venues and official hotels. Chaperones must report to the U.S. Championships Registration Room at the Official Hotel to receive credential.
3. The designated chaperone will be provided access to an open seating area within the main arena and practice arena designated for skaters and chaperones. There will be no reserved seating in this area during practice sessions or competitions.
4. Chaperones wishing to purchase reserved seating for their son/daughter's competitive events may purchase reserved seating by visiting www.2008stpaul.com.
5. One additional chaperone credential may be purchased for each qualifying competitor under the following circumstances:
 - A. Chaperones **must** be the parent or legal guardian over the age of 18.
 - B. A fee of \$125 is paid for the second chaperone credential.
6. The competitor or competitor's parents are solely responsible for the designation of the competitor's chaperones. Only the competitor or parent may change the designation of chaperones. Changes may only be made one time and **ONLY** at the 2008 U.S. Championships Registration Room.
7. There will not be hospitality offered to the chaperones at either arena or the hotels. The chaperone credential will only allow the chaperone into the arenas on the concourse level, into the designated open seating area in the main arena, and onto the official event transportation.
8. Chaperones that are accompanied by children under the age of 18 are permitted to purchase an accompanying credential including bus pass for \$50. This accompanying person credential does not provide access to reserve seating during competitive events. No chaperone credentials will be issued to family members under the age of 18, unless they are the named legal guardian.
