


The Wild play at Xcel Energy Center.

- Skyway Connection: RiverCentre Parking Ramp is directly connected to all event facilities through our climate-controlled skyway.
- Payment Options: RiverCentre Parking Ramp accepts most major credit cards and cash.
- Entrances: RiverCentre Parking Ramp has two entrances. The upper entrance is located on Kellogg Boulevard and the lower entrance is located at the intersection of Eagle Street and Chestnut Street.
- **Parker Assistance Services**: RiverCentre Parking Ramp is pleased to offer assistance with unlocking services, emergency starter services, towing, emergency fuel and tire assistance and late night security escorts to vehicles. For more information, call 612.330.0013.

FROM THE NORTH

I-35E south to 94 West. Exit on Marion Street. Turn left onto Kellogg Blvd. The RiverCentre parking ramp will be on your right.

FROM THE SOUTH

I-35E North to Kellogg Blvd exit. Turn right onto Kellogg Blvd. The RiverCentre parking ramp will be on your right.

FROM THE SOUTHEAST

US-52 North. Take the exit toward East 7th Street / MN-5. Turn left onto Kellogg Blvd. The RiverCentre parking ramp will be on your right.

FROM THE EAST

I-94 West. Exit on Marion Street. Turn left onto Kellogg Blvd. The RiverCentre parking ramp will be on your right.

FROM THE WEST

I-94 East to the Kellogg Blvd exit. Turn right onto Kellogg Blvd. The RiverCentre parking ramp will be on your right.

FROM THE AIRPORT

Follow signs for MN - 5 East to St Paul. Turn right onto Kellogg Blvd. The RiverCentre Parking Ramp will be on your right hand side.


- ADA Parking: RiverCentre Parking Ramp is equipped with ADA parking locations and elevator access to our event facilities.

There are several gates to enter Xcel Energy Center.

Gate 1 is located off Kellogg Boulevard.







The Box Office is located inside of Gate 1.

This is where I can purchase or pick up tickets.

There is an ADA accessible entrance located at Gate 1.








Gate 2 and Gate 3 are located off West 7th Street. There are ADA accessible entrances located at Gates 2 & 3.






Gate 4 is located off West Fifth Street and is ADA accessible. The Michelob Golden Light Taphouse is located inside of Gate 4.



Gate 5 is located in the skyway and is ADA accessible.

Gate 5 provides direct access to the Club and Suite Levels of the arena. Bags, purses and backpacks are not allowed. Clutch, wristlet and wallets sized 4" x 6" x 1.5" or smaller are allowed and subject to inspection.



*Medical bags and diaper bags are allowed; however, they are required to pass through x-ray screening prior to entry. Guests with medical and diaper bags must enter the arena at Gate 1.





After I enter a gate, I will go through a security checkpoint.

At the security checkpoint, I will be asked to empty any metal objects from my pockets (such as cell phone, keys, etc.) and pass through a metal detector. Once I am in the arena, there are a number of things I can see and do.

If I would like to check out sensory tools to use during the Wild game, I can visit Guest Services.

It is located at Section 105 between Gate 1 and Gate 2.









The Hockey Lodge is located near Gate 1.

This store sells Minnesota Wild apparel and merchandise. When I am ready to find my seat, I can find my section using the Xcel Energy Center seating map.







To get from the concourse on the 100 Level to the Club or 200 Level, I can use the stairs, escalator or elevator.

From my seat, I can enjoy the game and cheer for the Wild.

If the game is too loud or I need to move around, I can return to the concourse.





When the Wild score a goal, fans will cheer, a horn will sound and music will play. At times, the arena will be loud.

Headphones and earplugs are available at the Guest Services desk if I am concerned about the amount of noise. If I need assistance, there are many people who can help me.

Staff will have uniforms and name tags to help me identify them.
